#### 2024 Budget & Association Dues

The 2024 budget has been approved and the significant increases were in insurance, utilities and general maintenance. As a result, monthly dues will increase starting January 2024 by \$11, from \$205 to \$216. Landscaping dues for Village 18 & Village 20 will increase by \$15 from \$152 to \$167.
